City of Auburn Alternate Side Parking Information

When is alternate side parking in effect?

In accordance with §285-13 of The Code of The City of Auburn, <u>alternate</u> <u>side parking is enforced year round on every street</u> throughout the City of Auburn unless otherwise posted.

How do I know which side to park on?

Everyday at 6:00 pm is change over time.

For example, **August 24th** - Park on the side of the street with the **even numbered house starting at 6:00 pm** until 6:00 pm the following day. That means for most of the daylight hours you will need to park on the odd side of the street.

The following day, **August 25^{th-}** Park on the side of the street with the **odd numbered house starting at 6:00 pm** until 6:00 pm the following day. That means for most of the daylight hours you will need to park on the even side of the street.

Remember that occasionally there are two odd dates in a row, for example July 31st and August 1st. During those instances you would park on the odd side of the street two days in a row.

What if I forget to move my car?

Daily from <u>5:30 pm to 6:30 pm you have a grace period</u>. During this time alternate side parking regulations will not be enforced to allow a reasonable period of time to be legally parked. This provision shall not apply to any emergency occurrences or situations.

6:00 pm Daily Alternate Even Day = Even Side Odd Day = Odd Side.
